Thanks for contacting me regarding your outdoor party. Although the picnic area/playground cannot be restricted from use by other residents, I can put you on the website calendar and advise anyone else inquiring about that day that there is an event planned. The following are not allowed:

- Pony rides or traveling petting zoos anywhere on the community premises which includes the parking lot
- Crawfish boils anywhere on the premises or parking lot
- Activity on the grounds after 8 pm

There are restrooms (2) adjacent to the picnic area, 5 picnic tables and 2 charcoal grills. Please wipe off the picnic tables and clean the grills before you leave.

It's also a good idea to bring mosquito spray or fogger.

Please plan on bringing garbage bags. All filled garbage bags must be sealed and placed inside one of the large trash cans at bottom of deck stairs, with trash can lid secure. Any trash bags which do not fit inside these trash receptacles must be removed. Please do not leave any trash containers/bags on the deck or front porch of the clubhouse.

POOL RULES

- *In case of emergency call 911*
- *Warning: no lifeguard on duty - swim at your own risk*
- *Pool use by pool registered owners and guests only*
- *Pool hours: 8:00 am to 8:00 pm*
- *Swimmers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult of 18 years minimum*
- *No diving at shallow end no running or horseplay in or around pool area*
- *no glass containers in pool area*
- *No pets no loud music, no loud, abusive, or foul language*
- *Children's wading pool reserved for children 7 years and younger. Bathing suits are required and babies must wear panties with elasticized waist and legs.*
